FLASHBACK: DIRT ON HELENA FLAVERSHAM'S HANDS/DRESS.

SHERLOCK (V.O.)

In the case of Ms. Flaversham, I dismissed it as hard work. However, the cemetery gave me pause. The dirt was of darker coloring indicative of a nutrient rich place of origin. Moist but not mud as to be expected, having had rain in the early hours, suggesting a riverbank. But not one here in England! Leading me to my long sought after conclusion.
